Dear Mr. Summers:

Reference is made to your letter of May 10, 1965, in which you question your water assessment.

The records of the State Engineer's Office show that you own an interest in the Jackson Ditch Association, and this is the water you are being assessed for through our office.

During the past few years, Jackson Ditch Association has been receiving water out of Porcupine Reservoir through the Highline Canal rather than taking water directly out of the Little Bear River at the old point of diversion.

Our records show that in 1964, the Jackson Ditch Association was delivered 40.0 acre feet of water through the Highline Canal, and this is the water you are being assessed for by the State Engineer's Office.
