SUBJECT: Edgar Peterson vs. Mayfield Irrigation Company

On the morning of April 29, 1974, I answered the request of Mr. Edgar Peterson and traveled to Mayfield to discuss problems he was experiencing with Mayfield Irrigation Company. Mr. Peterson owns stock in the New Field and Old Field ditches, and he had requested to change 15 shares of Old Field stock into the New Field ditch. This application for a transfer was discussed at the annual stockholder's meeting. None of the Petersons attended this meeting and, consequently, the motion for a transfer was not seconded.

The problem was discussed with Mr. Edgar Peterson, Stanford Peterson, Neil Christiansen, Neil Roberts, and Gail Hansen. Mr. Hansen is president of the Mayfield Irrigation Company, and he indicated that the company was reluctant to transfer this water because of future complications with water users.

Because of this complication and because this is entirely an internal matter within the Mayfield Irrigation Company, Mr. Peterson was not allowed to transfer his shares, and the problem now rests.
