There has been some controversy between the Twin Lakes Reservoir Company and the Mayfield Irrigation Company in regard to the length of time the Twin Lakes Reservoir Company has the right to store water in Twin Lakes Reservoir, Dry hole, and the Mayfield Reservoir. Some maintain that they have the right to store water until July 1 and others claim they should stop on April 1.

I would appreciate it if you would send me a letter giving the opinion of your office in regard to this matter. I would also appreciate your opinion in regard to the right of the Twin Lakes Reservoir Company to the use of the two second feet of water from Birch Creek from July 1 to Oct. 1.

I hope you will be able to do this for us.
