Re: Examination of Nine Mile Area

On June 26, 1978 a field check of the Nine Mile area diversions was made by John Bene, Deputy State Engineer, LaMond Gardner and Bob Siefken from the Price Office.

There was approximately 1.0 cfs flowing in Nine Mile Creek at the confluence with Minnie Maude.

Motte was diverting approximately 1.25 cfs about 2.5 cfs going by.

Keel & Hammerschmidt had 4.0 cfs and about 0.75 cfs seeping through the dam, going down the creek.

Hammerschmidt had 2.9 cfs

Christensen ditch was dry.

Nev Wimmer at the Davis diversion had 2.5 cfs

Argyle Creek at the confluence had approximately 2.0 cfs

Nev Wimmer had approximately 0.5 cfs from Argyle. (No measuring device)

Pressett ditch had approximately .5 cfs (no measuring device)

Henry Mills had approximately 1.0 cfs (no measuring device)

Jack Wimmer had about 0.5 cfs (no measuring device)

Harmon Canyon diversion had about 3.5 cfs (no measuring device)

Nutter Corporation upper diversion had 2.4 cfs

Nutter Corporation lower diversion had 1.39 cfs
