Re: OGDEN RIVER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

The 1962 budget for the Ogden River Distribution System has been questioned by certain users from this system with regard to the amount of money allowed for committee expense. This office has reviewed this budget in detail, and while this item appears to us to be reasonable, we believe it is necessary and to the best interests of the system that a detailed accounting of the expenditure of these funds be made for the group at next year's water users meeting. This would allow us to satisfy all users that the amount requested is necessary and is being properly expended. We will expect such an accounting prior to the annual meeting next winter.

However, if there is money remaining in this fund after this year's operation, it must be applied to the next year's budget or to the Ogden River Distribution System's bank reserves to be used for future expenditures encountered in normal operating procedures benefiting all users of your system.

Two irrigation companies have refrained from joining the system's committee. We, however, feel justified in assessing the entire budget against all accounts as all moneys spent are for Ogden River distribution activities.

We trust this letter will advise all parties as to this matter and they will cooperate during this year.
