Dear Mr. Hansen:

The following is a report of water flows and water distribution on Pot Creek Water System for the year 1981. This was one of the poorest years for runoff in recent years.

At the Upper USGS Gauge, there was a total of 1,310 acre feet of water and at the Lower USGS Gauge (Colorado State Line), there was a total runoff of 48 acre feet. As you will notice, there was not much water to work with.

Water delivered during the summer by me was as follows:

Colorado	96 acre feet
Browns Park Waterfowl Management Area	160 acre feet
Max Rasmussen	42 acre feet
Allen Bennion	<u>10 acre feet</u>
Total	308 acre feet

We left as much water as possible in Calder and Crouse Reservoirs in hopes of preventing a winter loss of fish in these two waters. Both waters went into winter approximately one-half full and Matt Warner Reservoir was approximately one-fourth filled.
