
MEMORANDUM

Reference is made to your request to investigate the property ownership and water rights belonging to Zelf Calder and previously owned by Joseph O. Calder.

In regards to who is to pay the water assessment for 1966, there is a Warranty Deed recorded in the Uintah County Courthouse which indicates that Joseph O. Calder and Belva V. Calder granted to Zelf S. Calder and Bessie P. Calder the following described lands: The $W\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 1, $E\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 2, T1S, R23E, SLB&M along with 262/400 of 1/7 of the water in the Matt Warner Reservoir. The deed is dated December 29, 1965.




Gentlemen: RE: POT CREEK DISTRIBUTION
