Re: Matt Warner Reservoir Water Rights, Pot Creek

Zelph Calder is the owner of Matt Warner Reservoir which has a capacity of 2945 ac.-ft. as decreed in the Green River Adjudication. The following are the amounts and to whom Zelph Calder has sold portions of the Matt Warner Water Right.

1. In 1951 Zelph Calder sold, by quit claim deed 400 ac.-ft. of water to Lucille H. Calder. This left a total of 2545 in the reservoir for Zelph Calder.
2. In 1958 Zelph Calder sold by warranty deed to Allen Bennion 120/300 of 2545 ac.-ft. of water out of Matt Warner Reservoir which is a total of 101.8 ac.-ft. This leaves a total of 2443.2 ac.-ft. of water right in Matt Warner Reservoir for Zelph Calder.
3. The interest of Lucille Calder as mentioned in Article #1, 400 ac.-ft has since been conveyed to Joseph Calder. He in turn conveyed 138 ac.-ft to Carle Searle and Max B. Rasmussen, leaving 262.0 for Joseph Calder.

The following is a breakdown of the existing rights in Matt Warner Reservoir.
