Re: Spring Canyon District,
Demarco--Elegante.

Your letter of June 1st., and previous letters in regard to this matter, have been received and contents thereof noted. Pursuant to the request made in one of your letters, Mrs. Elegante has employed Mr. W. R. Wayman to put in the necessary wiers and measuring devices so that Mrs. Elegante will receive only such water as she is rightfully entitled to under the Decree of Court. Mr. Wayman will have these wiers and measuring devices in by not later than July 8th.

Mr. Wayman in this connection advised me that he had not as yet been appointed as the water commissioner to distribute this water in Spring Canyon wash for the year 1929. Mrs. Elegante is very eager that a commissioner be appointed to distribute the waters according to the decrees and respectfully requests that W. R. Wayman be appointed as the water commissioner to measure and distribute the water to the people entitled thereto, the expenses to be borne by the parties using said water. Mrs. Elegante has incessantly requested the Demarco people not to use water that belongs to her and she does not want to use water that does not belong to her and wants to avoid any possible trouble whatsoever.

We therefore respectfully request that you, as soon as it is conveniently possible for you to do so, appoint W. R. Wayman the water commissioner for the Spring Canyon District and that the Order further be made that the expenses of distributing this water be borne by the parties using said water. The expense of putting in the wiers are being borne entirely by Mrs. Elegante. Your early attention to this matter will be very much appreciated.
