RE: SPRING CANYON DIST.

I have your letter of Sept. 15 and have discussed the situation thoroughly with Mr. Jerman. Enclosed is copy of letter which I have written to Mr. Rugeri, and copy of which goes to Mrs. Eleganti.

It seems to me that with Mr. Rugeri's help we stand a fair chance of solving the trouble between the Elegantis and the DeMarcos. Mr. Jerman spoke of the pipe line and, while I recognize that diverting water through the pipe line probably exceeds the Eleganti rights, I am of the opinion that our chances of solving the trouble will be harmed rather than helped if we take any drastic action.

In my letter to Mr. Rugeri I am presenting a definite set of requirements, none of which are unreasonable, and if he will help in seeing that these requirements are carried out in good faith it should make a big difference in future operations. I will keep you advised of what progress I am making.
