Thank you for your letter of Aug. 30 and I am sorry that I got the impression that the Elegantis had agreed to divide the water up on the plan which I understood was suggested to them by you and Mr. Madsen.

The Elegantis took my letter about adequate headgates to their attorney and apparently were advised that if they piped Crystal Spring it would satisfy the legal requirements. As the law is very definite that headgates must be installed for every point of diversion I shall take this matter up with Mr. Ruggeri in the hopes that he may bring some influence to bear on the Elegantis.
