RE: PRICE RIVER DIST.

In further answer to your letter of Aug. 1 I would say that investigation disclosed that the Eleganti's have several points of diversion which apparently cannot be taken care of by one pipe line from Crystal Spring.

Under the law every water user must have and maintain an adequate headgate and measuring device at their points of diversion and it has occurred to me that it might perhaps help if I ordered these devices installed at once. Such an order would, of course, apply to you as well as the Elegantis and I would so word the order that the means of diversion would include a substantial headgate which could be locked. Even this might require fairly constant attendance of a deputy commissioner and so run the expense up quite high.
