RE: PRICE RIVER DIST:

Dear Madam:

I have your letter of July 16 with reference to the trouble you are having with the Elegantes.

I am quite familiar with the situation in Spring Canyon owing to an inspection which I have made myself and an accurate survey and examination made by a representative of this office. In view of the conditions as I believe them to be I decided early this spring to eliminate Spring Canyon from the jurisdiction of the Commissioner on Price River and, if necessary, make a separate district of it. The only way to distribute this water would apparently be by having the Commissioner on the ground every day and the cost of such distribution would have to be borne by you and the Elegantes. I estimate that the expense would be in the neighborhood of \$200.00 a month and am ready to arrange for it on that basis, if necessary.
