Mr. Don Jerman finished his map of the Spring Canyon Wash the middle of this week. I have been assured every day that Mr. King would be back and waited for him in the hopes that it might do away with some of the friction of a proper settlement. He is back in town but has important engagements this morning and may have to leave town Monday morning. I therefore, have written him and am enclosing copy of my letter to him and a copy of the memo.

It seems to me proper to let the Eleganti's have water for their lands under cultivation if they will behave. If they want to keep up the fight I see nothing for us to do but distribute the water strictly in accordance with the technical rights which means that the Eleganti's should not get any water until they have change their point of diversion and place of use by application to this office.
