Answering your letter of June 19 I am enclosing sheet showing simplest form of standard weir and on the back of this you will find table of flow. The only other method of measuring water is by current meter and I assume that you have no meter available. I think that Mr. Pace would be well advised to put in a cheap form of weir as shown on this sheet and he would be able to keep his own measurements if he so desired.
