



BOWL CREEK DISTRIBUTION

On Tuesday afternoon, May 1, 1928, Mr. Vern W. Pace and Mr. Clair M. Senior, his attorney, called at the office of the State Engineer with reference to water commissioner on Bowl Creek. They examined the file of Bowl Creek since the letter of the State Engineer to Mr. Senior under date of March 30, and expressed themselves as satisfied with the situation.

In part answer to the statements made by the Hall interests Mr. Pace said that Mr. Hall was invited to take part in the examination made by Mr. F. G. Weber, results of which were covered by Mr. Weber's affidavit, but that Mr. Hall did not appear. Later on another offer was made to Mr. Hall to repeat the investigation but was not accepted.

Mr. Senior said that he had advised Mr. Pace to put in a measuring device or at least to have another examination and report made by Mr. Weber. The State Engineer said that he considered there was no possibility of Mr. McBride being able to handle the work as suggested by the Halls' and that if the Halls' still insisted on the appointment of a commissioner he would appoint Mr. Weber. Mr. Pace expressed himself as satisfied with this arrangement and also stated that in case the Halls' withdrew their request for a commissioner he would make no such request but that he would have at least one more examination and report made by Mr. Weber.
