Dear Sir:

Upon the receipt, a short time ago, of your letter stating that Mr. Hall had asked for the appointment of S. E. Johnson of Hanksville as Water Commissioner in Bown Creek, we wrote to Mr. Vern Pace, and we are just in receipt of a letter from him stating that he does not know Mr. Johnson and does not know anyone in Hanksville who does know him, and that he would prefer to have someone who has lived in the vicinity longer, and is known there, act as commissioner.

Mr. Frank J. Weber, who acted last year, and who made a report to your office, is entirely satisfactory to Mr. Pace. At the time he was requested to act Mr. Weber was also satisfactory to Mr. Hall as far as we understand the situation. If there is any good reason why Mr. Weber should not continue to act we would appreciate it if you would inform us of the reason.

Mr. Pace, therefore, asks us to protest the appointment of Mr. S. E. Johnson and request the continued appointment of Mr. Frank J. Weber as Water Commissioner.
