RE: BOWL CREEK DIST.

Request having been made to this office some time ago for the appointment of a water commissioner on Bowl Creek and your name having been suggested I would be pleased to hear from you with reference to what compensation and expense would be required were you appointed.

As I understand the situation it is a matter of your going over to Bowl Creek occasionally and I believe you live near enough so that a trip with the necessary investigation could be made in one day. If this is the case it is a matter of your estimating how many trips would enable you to keep in touch with the division of the water to Mr. Pace and the allowing of such excess water to go down to the Hall land as would reach there in quantity to be of benefit. Do you consider it advisable to have the work start this late in the season?
