I have your letter of April 19 recommending the appointment of Mr. Alfred Ostberg of Cainville as water commissioner on Bowl Creek.

I note that you state he will perform the service at the rate of \$5.00 a day and 12½ cents mileage but you give me no idea whatever as to the number of days employment is required so it is impossible for me to fix up the total of the budget as necessary to levy the assessment as required by the statute.

Please let me know at once what seems to be the number of days service will be required and in the mean time I will consult with the attorney for Mr. Pace as required by law.
