

Cedar City, Utah, March 12, 1941.

The Water Users Committee of Coal Creek met in the Office of Cedar City Corporation in Cedar City at 7:30 P.M. March 12, 1941.

Geo.H.Wood, former Chairman of the Committee having passed on since the last meeting a new organization was effected. On motion of Ray Lunt, seconded by J.S.Woodbury, Roice Nelson was made Chairman of the Committee.

On motion of Parley Dalley, seconded by Will L.Jones, Ray Lunt was made Secretary of the Committee.

Coal Creek Water Users were represented as follows,-

Parley Dalley for South & West Field Irr.Co.

H.H.Lunt for Cedar City.

J.S.Woodbury for the Coal Creek Irr.Co.

Grant Hunter for the North Field Irr.Co.

Roice B.Nelson for the Union Field Irr.Co.

Ray Lunt for the Old Fort & Old Field Irr. Co.

Will L.Jones for the North West Field Irr. Co.

J.T.Leigh, Water Commissioner for Coal Creek, reported on the distribution for 1940. On motion of Parley Dalley seconded by Will L.Jones, his report was accepted.

The matter of diverting waters from the headwaters of Coal Creek was discussed, especially at the Woods Ranch in Cedar Canyon. A motion was made by J.S.Woodbury, seconded by Parley Dalley, instructing the Water Commissioner to follow the instructions of the State Engineer in regard to the water diverted at the Woods Ranch.

Parley Dalley made a motion, seconded by Will L.Jones, that the Commissioner see that no water was illegally diverted from the headwaters of Coal Creek and that he be allowed 6¢ per mile when attending such duty.

H.H.Lunt moved that we recommend to the State Engineer the appointment of J.T.Leigh for Water Commissioner for Coal Creek for the full year of 1941 and that his salary be \$25.00 per month for January, February, first half of March and December and \$50.00 per month for the remaining eight and one-half months. Motion was seconded by Parley Dalley and carried unanimously. (salary to be paid direct by water users)

Claim against the Mendenhall Construction Company for causing a dam to be thrown across the creek in Cedar Canyon and impounding the flow was discussed and on motion of Parley Dalley, seconded by H.H.Lunt, collection of the damages was authorized.

On motion of Will L.Jones, meeting adjourned.
