Dear Mr. Reese:

Attached herewith is our check in the amount of \$321.77 in payment of our share of the Coal Creek River Distribution System according to the attached statement.

In submitting this payment, we wish to state that we do not consider this a fair share of the distribution expenses to be charged to the Coal Creek Irrigation Company. We read your letter to Mr. Orville Isom dated May 9, 1960 accompanied by the enclosures. The question we raise is the amount of water which was shown delivered to the Coal Creek Irrigation Company in the year 1958. It does not seem possible that that much water could have been delivered.

For my own part, we own 273 shares of Class B water. During the high water flow of 1958, we did not get that many acres adequately watered. The water was not delivered to us. This, of course, was not the case with every stockholder; but it would appear that with that much water, there would have been enough to water all of the acreage owned by the Coal Creek Irrigation Company several times over. Your method of charging leaves us no alternative but to live with this figure for another four years which seems unreasonable.
