Dear Wayne:

Mr. Robert Porter, Hubert Lambert, and myself discussed the recent decision of the Supreme Court, relative to the Appeal of the Milford Valley Priority Users, when they were here on January 25 and 26. We agreed that the decision would allow all users to begin the 1960 season without any charge against them for excess pumpage in 1958 and 1959.

My 1959 Water Commissioners report is being compiled without showing excess pumpage in 1958 and 1959, but merely the water used in 1959 and the use rate in acre feet per acre.

Do you agree that this is proper? If you feel that the additional information should be included, I would appreciate your suggestions before I do further work.
