RE: Coal Creek Water Users Meeting

Mr. Thelmer Stratton, secretary of Coal Creek Water Users Association, was in the office today and arrangements were made to hold the annual meeting in the city and county building, Cedar City, Utah at 7:30 p.m., February 23, 1960. Mr. Stratton assumes that the State Engineer will notify the Water Users by notice to the Presidents of the canal companies (and also the secretaries). If this suggested time and place for the annual meeting does not meet with your approval, notify Mr. Thelmer Stratton and myself immediately.

Since the present distribution of water on Coal Creek ends March 15, 1960, the assessments should be prepared, as far as possible, so that they can be mailed soon after the annual meeting. Otherwise, there will be no money available to pay the commissioner after March 15. Any preparations which can be made now, will help to have money coming in as needed.

Check through your records on Coal Creek Distribution and let me know of the information that is available. This would include water commissioner reports, U.S.G.S. gauging station records on Coal Creek, and any miscellaneous measurements that have been made.

If there are any questions as to the parties who should be notified of the annual meeting, request the information directly from Mr. Thelmer Stratton Cedar City, Utah
