

ON THE COAL CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.

Dear Mr. Watson:

① We as Surety executed the captioned bond in the amount of \$1000.00 for the period beginning May 1, 1944, and ending May 1, 1945. The authority for the issuance of this bond was your letter of April 27, 1944, directed to Andrus-Hafen Co., St. George, Utah. This letter was forwarded to us by W. O. Bentley, St. George, Utah, the succeeding agent, through our special agent, Mr. S. E. Rich, of Salt Lake City.

② We understand that the premium for our bond has not as yet been paid and also that it is your contention the check remitted for this bond was sent to Andrus-Hafen Co. and then forwarded to Laron Andrus who probably cashed it, no doubt for the premium on the old bond covering the period prior to May 1, 1944.

③ Inasmuch as you have no record of the previous bond, we believe that you should contact Laron Andrus to account for the proceedings of the check as he is not entitled to it. The premium should be paid to our Agent, W. O. Bentley of St. George, Utah.

④ May we ask that you review this matter and advise us what action has been taken.
