Dear Sir: RE: COAL CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM -
 Commissioner's Bond.

On June 26, 1944, I mailed to Andrus-Hafen Company, St. George, Utah, a letter, and a check, \$5.00, to cover the premium on a surety bond to be executed for J. T. Leigh, Cedar City, Utah, the appointed water commissioner.

It appears that Andrus-Hafen Company had sold its agency to W.O. Bentley, St. George, Utah. The request for the bond was forwarded to Mr. Bentley by someone not known to me. Mr. Bentley executed the bond, which has been received.

Both Orval Hafen and W. O. Bentley disclaim any knowledge of the check. A new check has been issued to Mr. Bentley. I wish to locate the check issued in June, and cancel it.

Of course you would not have an official record of the handling of this mail, which was not registered, but it may be that your office has some recollection or surmise with respect to the person to whom the letter in all probability was delivered.
