Mr. Cottrell, from the State Engineer's Office met with the Water Users.

The Water Users were represented as follows:

Moroni Perry for the South and West Field.  
Ray Lunt for the Old Fort and Old Field.  
J.S. Woodbury for the Coal Creek Irrigation Co.  
Grant Hunter for the North Field.  
Roice Nelson for the Union Field.  
Will L. Jones for the Northwest Field.

A majority of the water Users being represented the following business was transacted:

Roice Nelson was made Chairman of the meeting and Ray Lunt Secretary.

The annual report of the distribution of the waters of Coal Creek for 1943 was made by J.T. Leigh, Water Commissioner, and approved.

Motion by Ray Lunt that J.T. Leigh be recommended for appointment of Water Commissioner for 1944 was seconded by J.S. Woodbury and passed.

Motion was made by Willard Lunt, seconded by Moroni Perry, that no water be allowed for use at Wood's ranch and that the Owners be so notified.
