A meeting of the Coal Creek Water Users was held at the Cedar City Municipal Building at 1:00 P.M. on February 25, 1954.

Notice of the call of the meeting was read by the Secretary and incorporated as a part of the minutes of the meeting.

The minutes of the meeting held on February 24, 1953, were read for purposes of information; and the minutes of the meeting of February 15, 1954, were read and approved.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, Theron Ashcroft is recommended to the State Engineer for the position of Water Commissioner for the Coal Creek Distribution System for the ensuing year and that the sum of \$5.00 be forwarded to the State Engineer for the cost of the Water Commissioner's bond.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, it was decided that the Coal Creek Water User's Association would set up their own budget, make their own assessments and collect the same without requiring the assistance of the office of the State Engineer.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, assessment of Southern Utah Power Company was set at thirty (30) per cent but not to exceed \$360.00 for the company year, and that the assessments of all other water users would be on the same basis as during the year 1953.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, a budget in the sum of \$1660.00 was adopted for the ensuing year.

Theron Ashcroft, Water Commissioner, made his report for the past year and recommended that a solution was needed for winter water, but action thereon was deferred until receipt of a further report by the State Engineer.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
