You are reminded that in a letter dated April 12, you were required to submit to the State Engineer, plans and specifications for controlling head gate at the head of your canal and for a Parshall measuring flume to be installed in the canal downstream from the head gate.

It was required in said letter that plans and specifications for these structures be submitted to the State Engineer in sufficient time that they might be approved and the structures installed before the irrigation season of 1950. You are, therefore, urged to submit the plans and specifications in order that the construction work may be accomplished before winter sets in.
