Gentlemen: Re: COAL CREEK DISTRIBUTION

It has come to the attention of this office that you do not have adequate control gate at the head of your joint canal, neither do you have a measuring device. You are therefore hereby required under Section 100-5-4, Utah Code Annotated 1943 to submit to this office plans and specifications for a control head gate that can be set and locked, and for a Parshall flume to measure the water. It is understood that you have arrangements downstream on your joint canal for dividing the water to which the two corporations are entitled. If not, you should also make arrangements for the proper measuring and splitting devices to make the division between the two companies as their rights exist. It is not required by the State Engineer that plans and specifications for these structures for the division between the two companies be submitted. However, it is required that the measuring device at the head of the canal and the control head gate be covered by plans and specifications submitted to the State Engineer for his approval.

Due to the fact that the irrigation season is now upon you, you are urged to submit the plans in order that they may be approved, and that you make the installation as soon as possible. However, it is hereby required that the installations be made before the irrigation season of 1950.
