Memorandum: Coal Creek Distribution

The Coal Creek Water Users' Association met February 24, 1958 and unanimously recommended that Clemont Adams be continued as Coal Creek Water Commissioner in 1958. The State Engineer was notified of this action by letter dated March 7, 1958.

In response to this letter, a meeting was arranged between the State Engineer and the Coal Creek Water Users Committee. This meeting was held April 1, 1958 at 7:30 P.M. in the City Building in Cedar City, Utah.

The meeting was carried out as follows: Mr. Wayne Criddle, the State Engineer, acknowledged the recommendation of the Coal Creek Water Users of Mr. Clemont Adams for Coal Creek Water Commissioner during the 1958 irrigation season and his qualifications for the job were agreeable to all present.

Mr. Criddle stated that no Water Commissioner Reports on Coal Creek had been submitted to the State Engineer for several years. The committee said that they thought this matter had been taken care of by the previous commissioners. However, in the case of the 1957 report, Mr. Adams had not been instructed to make a report to the State Engineer. Daily flow records are available for the 1957 distribution and it was agreed by Mr. Adams and the water users that a report should and would be prepared as soon as time permits. Also, the Commissioner agreed to make a report of 1958 distribution in accordance with suggestions made by the State Engineer.

The group was advised that Mr. Adams would be appointed and placed under bond to act as commissioner for this coming water season.
