*Re: Coal Creek*

Gentlemen:

This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated June 3, 1958, in which you inform us concerning the distribution of Coal Creek Class "B" water by Mr. Adams, our water commissioner.

This is to inform you that our record of the interviews with you confirm your statements as indicated in your schedule. However, this matter has not yet been changed in the court and the Coal Creek Irrigation Company and other users who may be affected by this modification have not consented to delivery to your company of this water. Therefore, at the present time it appears that Mr. Adams will not be able to deliver the water as set up in your schedule unless you can prevail upon the Coal Creek Irrigation Company to release, by letter to us, the water which you claim has been transferred from them to you.

We have spent considerable time in investigating changes in the water rights as set forth in the Coal Creek Decree. We hope that within the next year to have a revised version of the determination which will be ready for distribution purposes.

Until that time, unless you can get the arrangement above referred to, it appears as though the water commissioner will have to deliver water strictly on the basis of the Cedar Valley Determination and the Coal Creek Decree as he is now doing.
