Dear Mr. Lambert:

I am working on a schedule to show the actual amount of Class 1, 2, 3, and 4-A water which has been applied to the irrigated land in Cedar Valley from Coal Creek during the past ten years. I use daily readings on the canals and take the average time interval between readings and convert to acre feet. I have these readings for the years 1952, 1953, 1954, 1955 and 1957. Mr. Treharne Leigh told me at one time that he had sent daily readings into your office for the years 1948, 1949, 1950, 1951 and 1956.
