I have your letter of September 18 and am afraid that, in common with some of the other water commissioners, you consider that this office has a general fund from which to pay compensation and expense. As a matter of fact the only money for that purpose is money which is contributed by the water users on their distribution assessment and when these assessments are not paid the State Engineer is left without the corresponding amount of money.

I find that we have approximately \$5.00 still left in the distribution fund and I will again renew my efforts to collect enough to take care of your account.
