I have your letter of Aug. 14 and regret that the situation on Sand Wash is so confused. I am afraid that nothing but a court action will straighten this situation out and that will cost the water users more money than would be required to fix their headgates and measuring devices up in a satisfactory condition and pay such distribution assessments, as well as enable the Commissioner to distribute the water strictly according to the rights.

I am sure that Mr. Marchant is making every effort to distribute the water properly within the limits of the satisfactory equipment at his disposal.
