Replying to your letter of May 31 I would say that I have already written to Mr. Marchant to learn what services will be required on Sand Wash so that I may fix up the assessment roll properly.

I am not at all keen on appointing a commissioner for Sand Wash if it means a continuation of the trouble which Mr. Marchant had with the Case and Cannon right. Apparently he could get no proper assistance from either the County Attorney or the District Attorney and it seems foolish to put him in a position of giving orders which are openly ignored and which he cannot have sufficient backing to enforce.
