RE: MUDDY CREEK DIST.

Thank you for your letter of June 4 with reference to the appointment of a water commissioner for Muddy Creek and I appreciate the attitude you are taking in this unfortunate matter.

I wish you would get in touch with the Emery people and see if we can reach an understanding with reference to the total compensation and expense of a water commissioner for this season. Under the law I am required to assess this total pro rata at once and collect the same before July 1.

It was my understanding that any of the three men mentioned when I was down last Thursday are agreeable to the Emery people therefore, I am inclined, under all the circumstances, to appoint Mr. Peter Anderson. You might, without telling them of any decision of mine, sound them out along that line.

I mailed to you yesterday a couple of copies of the little weir sheet which the office is getting out and which I think will be sufficient guide for present purposes. Please let me hear from you in regard to this total compensation matter at once as that information is necessary before making the appointment; also that Mr. Anderson will take the job for the agreed amount.
