Dear Mr. Morgan:

Thank you for taking the time to meet with us last Spring. We were pleased with the outcome.

Although, the situation concerning "Indian Water Rights" is in a more confused state than it was at that time, we still feel that we need a clarification on the following points:

- 1: A listing of the priorities of water rights on the White Rocks and Uintah Rivers.
2. A statement verifying the "Beneficial Use" ruling. (Last year several irrigation companies claimed they had filings that were ahead of ours. It was found that they were claiming filings that were made before the "Beneficial Use" ruling was made.)
3. A statement clarifying Culinary and Stock Water filings. (What are the flow rates, or how many second feet constitute culinary water?)

It is going to be extremely difficult to get our water this year. Therefore, we would like the above information before the winter storage season starts.

At this point we don't know if a public meeting is needed or not.
