In response to the letter dated October 22, 1985 from the United States Bureau of Reclamation, the relative rights of the Mosby Irrigation Company and the owners of water rights in Dry Fork Creek and Ashly Creek were settled by a Supplemental Decree dated August 28, 1964 made and entered in Uintah County, Civil No.: 18 and the Interlocutory Decree dated August 28, 1964 made and entered in the General Ajudication proceedings identified as Duchesne County Civil No.: 3070 and Uintah County Civil No.: 3804. Since the effective date of the foregoing Decrees, the Mosby Irrigation Company has been ready and willing to take whatever action is necessary to conform its applications to the foregoing Decrees.


Over the years, several meetings have been held with representatives of the State Engineer for that purpose, but no specific course of action has been formulated. We were hopeful that a final Decree could be entered in the General Ajudication proceedings (Duchesne County Civil 3070, Uintah County Civil 3804) to finally resolve the matter.

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Pending the final resolution of the above, the Mosby Irrigation Company has deemed it essential to the protection of its water rights to repeatedly file requests for extensions of time under its above-numbered applications. Mosby Irrigation Company is most anxious to finally resolve this matter to avoid the time and expense of further extensions of time and would be pleased to meet for that purpose at your early convenience.
