Gentlemen:

This letter is in response to your request dated September 13, 2007 for mapping of the current acres irrigated by our Company.

Unlike most of the other irrigation companies diverting water from the Jordan River, acreages in the area of our approved place of use (generally north of I-80 and north and west of the SLC International Airport) remain undeveloped and are in agricultural or wetland production. In accordance with Change Applications a17056 and a20607, our company is in the process of identifying which of those acreages will be permanently served with our water rights.

However, in conjunction with our most recent approve Change Application a28951, filed jointly with Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District and the LDS Church, an extensive map of our service area, our canal system and its some 40 head gate structures was submitted to John Mann and Jared Manning of your offices. Should that map no longer be in your files, we can provide you with a duplicate.
