Dear Gaylord,

I am in receipt of your letter expressing your concerns about the Distribution Assessment you received and paid, and acknowledge your protest, and offer the following explanation:

This is a distribution assessment fee to cover water commissioner activity. The water commissioner duty is the activity it takes to track all pump and surface -serviced & irrigated acreage in the cedar valley. This is not a fee for the "water rights" associated with the well you are in the progress of developing.

Along with a print of the Distribution accounts 100398 for groundwater and 103422 under the surface rights summary pages for those two accounts wherein the Paiute Tribe is billed, I have also enclosed a copy of the corresponding water rights summary pages as related to the rights shown. Note that the "Kingsbury Trust et. al... Multiple Owners" are simply added for reference as they are other Water Rights owners additionally shown on the summary page. You are not being billed for their acreage. The Distribution system bills accumulated amounts totaling over 5 acres, and your portion shows as 10 acres – for pumps (groundwater) along with the 18.12 acres of surface water. Both of these amounts qualify and are billed at the minimum assessment amount. If any of these amounts are in error we should discuss discrepancies.

Additionally I have enclosed a short description of the creation of the Cedar Valley Pumps- Distribution cover letter and the Cedar Valley Surface cover letter sent previously with the initiation of the system in 2011 and with the first round of Distribution billing sent in 2014. You may or may not have received those letters at that time, however these provide some further explanation.

I can also direct you to our website where you can find Water Commissioner Distribution reports on the system, if you provide an email or you can contact me at the number below and I can direct you to the appropriate spot on the website if you have an internet connection to find these reports.

I hope that provides some support and documentation to further your understanding about the nature of the assessment billing. If you need more details I would encourage you to contact me with additional questions, by calling 801 538-7430 or by email at MikeSilva@utah.gov

Cedar Valley Water User:

Dear Water User:

The Division of Water Rights is initiating a mapping effort beginning in 2012, to document actual irrigated acreage in Cedar Valley in comparison with water right records.

In the past, water use in Cedar Valley was monitored by measurement of the surface diversions and also by metering wells to measure groundwater pumped. Maintaining water meters has proved to be problematic, so pumped wells have effectively not been monitored over the past several years. Once the mapping project is completed, ground water use in Cedar Valley will be monitored by mapping irrigated acres according to the limitations described in each water right.

During our mapping effort, the Division will be reviewing irrigation in Cedar Valley using water right records and aerial photos. Once completed, the new method for monitoring groundwater use will be more accurate and will be representative of actual farming efforts in the Cedar Valley area.

In the process of shifting to the new map based monitoring, we will be reviewing the distribution assessment accounts and determine changes that may be needed. There are accounts being added, and in some cases combined with other accounts, based on farm operations. Also some accounts will be dropped.

Since we will be in the process of reviewing water rights against actual irrigated acres, the Division highly recommends that each water user review their water rights of record to insure they are irrigating in conformance with the limits of their water right or make appropriate changes to update their water rights records as necessary to reflect current conditions. Water users operating beyond the limits of their water right may be subject to enforcement actions, which could result in monetary penalties being assessed.

Dear Cedar Valley Surface Water User:

On February 18, 2014, the Division of Water Rights conducted a public meeting in Cedar City, Utah to establish a distribution system for the well water users in Cedar Valley. Each of the water users in the well water distribution system is responsible to help fund the operation of the new system including the new water commissioner's salary and other necessary expenses.

The existing surface water commissioner will continue to distribute the waters of Coal Creek. The surface water users are responsible to pay the costs of distributing the surface water including the surface water commissioner's salary and other necessary expenses. (The well water users will be assessed for the well water commissioner but will no longer contribute to funding the Coal Creek commissioner.) The portion of the total expenses each water user is required to pay is based on the amount of surface water diverted in proportion to the total amount of surface water used by the entire distribution system.

Find enclosed your assessment invoice for the 2014 assessment billing. If you use both surface water and well water in Cedar Valley you will be receiving a separate or "secondary" assessment for the well water distribution system.

Although the due date for the assessment payment shows May 1st, the actual due date for payment receipt has been extended to July 1st. Please note: a 10% delinquent charge will be added for outstanding balances on July 15th.

Dear Cedar Valley Well Water User:

On February 18, 2014, the Division of Water Rights conducted a public meeting in Cedar City, Utah to establish a distribution system for the well water users in Cedar Valley. The distribution system consists of a water commissioner, a committee representing the water users, and all of the well water users in the valley with rights to irrigate five acres or more. As discussed at the meeting, the water commissioner is responsible to annually map the land irrigated by wells.

Each of the water users in the well water distribution system is responsible to help fund the operation of the distribution system including the new water commissioner's salary and other necessary expenses. The portion of the total expenses each water user is required to pay is based on the amount of well water rights owned in proportion to the total amount of well water rights in the distribution system. The minimum assessment amount is now \$20.

The surface water commissioner will continue to distribute the waters of Coal Creek. However, the surface water users are now solely responsible to pay the costs of distributing surface water including the surface water commissioner's salary and other necessary expenses.

Find enclosed your assessment invoice for the 2014 assessment billing. Attached to the invoice is a slip showing the information pertinent to your account as follows:

Column 1 – Account Number; Column 2 – Account Owner; Column 3 – Water Right Number; Column 4 – Type of Right (Underground or Surface); Columns 5, 6 and 7 – Location: Section, Township, and Range of irrigated land; Column 8 – Number of allowed acres; and Column 9 – Priority Date. Column 10 (number in yellow) is the total acres for water rights shown in your account and is the basis of billing on the enclosed invoice.

Although the Due date for the assessment payment shows May 1st, the due date for payments has been extended to July 1st, note a 10% delinquent charge will be added for outstanding balances on July 15th.

	This change application is based on water right 73-422. This water right has a 1903 priority date and is based on Award 10 of the Coal Creek Decree and is listed in the decree as a class 4A right. Historically, this water right was diverted from Coal Creek and used to irrigate 18.12 acres of irrigation.
	The Coal Creek Decree clearly identifies the classes of water rights, the priority dates and the flows with the associated awards.
	The awards listed as Class 1, have a priority date of 1870 and the flows are from 0.0 Cubic Feet per Second (CFS) to 25.19 CFS.
	The awards listed as Class 2, have a priority date of 1880 and the flows are from 25.19 CFS to 34.86 CFS.
	The awards listed as Class 3, have a priority date of 1890 and the flows are from 34.86 CFS to 38.53 CFS.

The awards listed as Class 4A, have a priority date of 1903 and the flows are from 38.53 CFS to 102.02 CFS.

It is a well-established legal principal that a water right cannot be bettered nor enlarged by virtue of a change application. It is the nature of water rights in surface sources to provide less than a full supply on a consistent basis. Such sources typically vary with season and with meteorological cycles. The state's courts have ruled that, when a change application is approved to move a water right from its historic source to a new source, the applicant cannot take any more water from the new source than was/is available at the original source. In order to evaluate this application, it is necessary that the State Engineer assess the degree to which the historic source has provided a full supply of water, defined as a quantity sufficient to fully satisfy the beneficial use described for the underlying water rights being changed. The State Engineer's opinion is that any analysis of historic water availability should be based on the best data available and correlated such that the analysis best approximates long term water availability.

Typically, a change in point of diversion can only be approved if the amount of water to be diverted and used from the new source is limited to that which has been or would be available for diversion and use at the proposed source. To evaluate the amount of water historically available at the surface source, personnel of the State Engineer's office examined historic records available from the United States Geological Survey. These records were obtained from the United States Geological Survey's website and from the data entitled Water data for Utah: USGS Surface-Water Monthly Statistics. The study reviewed the flow data for Coal Creek for 75 years, from 1938 to 2012. The results of the study indicate that water rights derived from award 4A of the Coal Creek Decree historically were available 26.29% of the time.

A Memorandum explaining the analysis used to calculate these values can be found on the file for this water right, 73-422.

Based on this study, the maximum that could be converted from the historic surface source to an underground source would 19.0548 acre-feet, which would be limited to 4.7637 acres of irrigation.
