NOTICE OF LOWERING OF WATER LEVELS

TO THE UTAH STATE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
DIVISION OF WILDLIFE RESOURCES

Under Section 23-15-5, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, OTTER CREEK RESERVOIR COMPANY hereby gives notice that on August 1, 1978 at the hour of 6:00 o'clock a.m. it will close the gates on its Reservoir in Piute County to the extent that as little as ten (10) cubic feet of water per second will flow in the Kingston Canyon Section of the East Fork of the Sevier River until such time as procedures for eradication of excess accumulations of moss in a four-mile segment, beginning near the outlet of the Reservoir and extending down-stream four miles, can be completed.

Eradication of the moss overgrowth is required to permit water to flow through the channel and to prevent excessive wastages of water and will be effected through application of a chemical marketed under the trade name of "XYLENE" to the moss-grown areas.
