

Minutes of the Meeting of Water Users of
The Provo River Distribution System

DATE: February 17, 1959
TIME: 10:00 A.M.
PLACE: Provo, RUtah

The meeting was called to order by Chairman A.P. Hicken. The minutes of the annual meeting held February 3, 1959 were read and approved.

An application for Provo River Commissioner by Don A. Wright was read and filed.

Chairman Hicken asked for any remarks from the following applicants, M.J. Clark, Don A. Wright, W.A. Wayman and Isaac Baum, and each gave his qualifications for the position.

Mr. Godby of the Provo River Water Users Association gave a few remarks on how he thought the voting should be conducted and then introduced Attorney Novak, who then explained the different ways of voting, such as voting by stock or by individual. He emphasized that most voting was done by stock.

After Attorney Novak sat down Attorney Clyde discussed the various ways of voting but he emphasized that the voting should be by people using the water and not by stock.

After Sttorney Clyde concluded, remarks were made on the question of voting by Mr. Stratton, Mr. Clegg, Mr. Burr, Mr. Davies, Mr. Knight and Mr. Page.

A motion was made to refer this voting question to the executive committee, but died, due to no second.

Remarks were made by Mr. Lambert, Mr. Madsen, Mr. Lunceford, Mr. Carter, Mr. Giles, Mr. Anderson and Mr. Young.

A motion was made and seconded to vote by stock. A substitute motion was made and seconded to vote by individual. The substitute motion was voted on and passed, the motion was voted down.

The names M.J. Clark and W.A. Wayman were nominated for Provo River Commissioner and Isaac Baum was nominated for Deputy River Commissioner.

The votes were cast giving W.A. Wayman a majority for the River Commissioner along with Isaac Baum for Deputy River Commissioner.

The minority vote wished to go on record that they were opposed to voting by individual users rather than by stock.

Meeting adjourned.
