

Re: Provo City Decreed Water Rights in Thomas and  
Fish Hatchery Springs, South Fork, Provo Canyon

Dear Mr. Norseth:

I enclose herewith, certified copies of the Deeds running to Provo City covering the property whereon the Thomas and Fish Hatchery Springs emanate in the South Fork of Provo Canyon. Your attention is also called to Item 80 of Civil No. 2888 of the Fourth Judicial District in and for Utah County, State of Utah. This Decree is commonly known as the Morse Decree adjudicating water rights in and to the Provo River. Item "(h)" and item "(i)" are the adjudicated rights now owned by Provo City, said city owning all of the South Fork trout company right, and one-half interest in and to the right designated as Charles W. Thomas and Charles E. Giles.

Provo City hereby requests that you distribute to said City the Decreed right for irrigation purposes under item "(h)" to .50 second feet of water, and likewise distribute to said city as indicated in item "(i)", one-half of the .67 second feet there adjudicated as irrigation right. It is the request of Provo City that this distribution be made at the source, which is the location of the springs identified in the aforesaid decree.

It is our further request that an order be prepared and submitted to the Provo River Water Commissioner instructing him to make distribution in accordance with this request and the record of title furnished to your office herewith.

If there is any further information you may need regarding this matter, please advise and the same will be immediately transmitted to you.
