Your letter received relative to the appointment of water commissioner and in reply to your inquiry about the Joint committee representing the water users of Spanish Fork river.

This committee represents the five canal companies of the river, one man from each canal Co. and these men are elected by the stock holders of their respective company and the selection of a river commissioner rests with them.

The Strawberry Water users committee is also elected by the water users and these two committees meet jointly when selecting a river commissioner.

The river commissioners term expires Oct. 15, but he take measurements of the river after that time and he is usually retained by the Strawberry water users Ass'n. Hoping this information will be satsisractorly.
