Dear Mr. Ercanbrack:

This office has been requested by the State Engineer to initiate legal proceedings to have you comply with an order of the State Engineer dated April 8, 1964, relative to measuring devices and control structures on the South Fork of the Provo River.

In reviewing the Engineer's order I find you were ordered to install a metal or concrete parshall flume in the left-hand Fork back of the Summer House at a point above the pipe line diversion, where all the water will be measured. This flume need not have a measuring capacity to exceed 1 1/2 cfs. The Engineer's office advises me that as of this date you have failed to make this installation.

If there is some reason for your noncompliance with this order, I would appreciate hearing from you, otherwise I will request the State Engineer to again inspect your diversion on June 21, 1965, and if the above installation has not been made, I will file the appropriate action in the District Court.
