Re: Parshall Flume - Wilcox Flat

Dear Water Users:

At the annual meeting of the Mill Creek Distribution System held April 5, 1989, there was much concern expressed over the apparent dry irrigation season that lies ahead. Some concern was expressed about the measuring device for the Wilson-Mesa Irrigation Company. It is located some distance from the point of diversion. As a result of our discussion, I feel that it would be advisable to move the flume to either the open section in the pipeline near the diversion, or the end of the pipeline, if there is sufficient fall in the line and ditch to operate the flume correctly, and not interfere with your ability to divert water. All of the other diversions on the system have their measuring devices near the point of diversion. This is the proper way to measure the water that is being diverted into your ditch.

Therefore, I am requesting that this be accomplished prior to any water being diverted this irrigation season. If you need assistance in this matter, I would be happy to meet with the Company. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me at your convenience. As always, your cooperation is appreciated.
