Replying to your letter of April 17, 1986:

Ray and Ellen Alger asked that 12 of their Moab Irrigation Company shares of stock be held for use on the Mesa - Horse Creek Diversion, and this was approved by our Board for 1986 on February 11, 1986.

Delivery of this water on the Mesa is, as I am sure you understand, subject to a 15% evaporation loss, and I so notified the Algers in my letter to them regarding approval of their application. Therefore they will be entitled to 43.146 AF for this 12 shares. (12 shares x 4.23 AF less 15%)
