WATER RIGHTS

Mill Creek

The following is a brief summary of the water rights of record in the office of the State Engineer on Mill Creek and tributaries thereto.

The first, second and third class water rights on Mill Creek were defined in the Ferdinand Erickson Decree dated December 14, 1908 followed by a supplemental decree by Judge A.H. Christensen dated August 10, 1910, both Civil 170, Seventh Judicial District Court, Grand County, Moab Irrigation Company et al Plaintiffs vs the Wilson Mesa Irrigation Company et al Defendants. The decreed duty for the plaintiffs and defendant D.A. Johnson was 1.0 sec.ft./55 acres.

First Right (Prior to 1891) Moab Irrigation Co. et al

Sufficient water to irrigate 1119.5 acres and sufficient for culinary and domestic purposes.

1119.5 acres/55 acres/sec.ft. = 20.35 sec.ft. plus culinary and domestic water. 19/20 or 19.33 sec.ft. to Moab Irrigation Company and 1/20 or 1.02 sec.ft. to John and Delilah Peterson (Emma Walker) plus culinary and domestic water to each.

Second Right (1891)

Sufficient water to irrigate 175 acres. $175/55 = 3.18$ sec.ft. as follows:
