Dear Mr. Bacon:

We wish to thank you for sending Mr. Jerman out to inspect the Dry Gulch Creek and the Montez Creek. Since the inspection was made our officials are even more strongly impressed that some action should be taken to place these streams under the strict supervision of your office. It is fully realized that little or no benefits can be gotten from irrigation water this season, but on the other hand, we feel convinced that if these two streams are to be put under the strict control of your office it is going to be necessary to gradually place the various matters in a shape that supervision can be given. Our definite aim is to get a Commissioner appointed this year whom we hope will be able to see that proper control gates and measuring devices are installed so that when next year comes, all the necessary gates and measuring devices will be installed which are necessary to insure the fair distribution of water in these creeks.

We are therefore, formally asking you to take steps for the appointment of a Commissioner for the Dry Gulch, Montez and Sandwash Creeks. We are not suggesting any names for the appointment as we feel that you will probably want to call a meeting of all the users and we are willing to abide by the expression of the majority opinion if the meeting is called.


Since Mr. Jerman was here, we have found that approximately 6 c.f.s. of water was being diverted from Montez Creek the day inspection was made about a mile above the upper point where the creeks were inspected, so the flow of the creek was better then it was supposed to have been.
