

MEMORANDUM

MONTEZ CREEK, DUCHESNE COUNTY.

June 5, 1931, the writer accompanied by Mr. Allred of Dry Gulch Irrigation Company visited Montez creek making observation as to the general flow of the two forks of this creek at the confluence and the location of diversion and place of use of the various rights on the lower end of the creek. Time did not permit us to reach the upper diversion, where no doubt, most of the water was being diverted, for there was only a trace or no water at the points we visited.

We also visited the points of diversions proposed in the Dry Gulch Irrigation Company's filing No. 10909. The quantity of water flowing in the creek was small. I understand up to three weeks ago there had been a fair quantity, averaging approximately 10 c.f.s. flowing passed the State Highway south of the confluence of the two forks. The Dry Gulch Irrigation Company feels that the distribution of this creek had reached the point where it was absolutely necessary that a water Commissioner be appointed early in the spring in order that the early water as well as the summer water could be properly distributed to the rightful owners.
